The idea:

To design your own valentine's card from scratch using candy. This gift idea will take a bit of time looking for the right 'candy names' needed to make this card work. The concept behind the card is to write your feelings, or tell a story, with actual candy as part of your story.

As you have noticed that there is a creative side needed to make and design some of these gifts. If you have any trouble writing your story, I recommend you go onto the internet for ideas (love poems and/or stories) or through books at your local library. You are going to tell her a story about how you feel, how you see your relationship with her, or any other short story that will make her cry. Yes, you can see that hitting her emotions is the true way to win her over with these gift ideas

For example:

- 1) When Cupid shot his arrows (but use small 'Arrow chocolate bars' instead of arrows but draw the front and back of arrow around chocolate bar).
- 2) You are my Sweetheart (but use the 'Sweetarts candy' instead of the word sweetheart).

3) When I first met you, you were all dressed up (but use a small bag of 'All Dressed potato chips' instead of the words 'all dressed up').

Ingredients:

2 x (2 feet x 3 feet) cardboard 4 x (2 feet x 3 feet) Colored heavy stock construction paper Glue – white glue and glue stick Colored markers Duck tape for binding Candy – various types

Instructions:

- 1) Have you love message always written out with candy and practice a few different layouts on the cardboard?
- 2) Take you two pieces of cardboard and place them (one inch apart) beside each other. Use a three foot length of duct tape to hold the pieces togeth er on both sides. Make sure that there is an inch between. This will help make room for the different sizes of candy.
- 3) Glue the colored pieces of construction paper onto all four sides.
- **4)** Write out your message (On front of card and in the middle) with a black marker leaving space for the particular candy or treat that will take the place of certain words.
- **5)** Glue the candy into place. Try to have then in strategic locations so that when the card is closed to pieces of candy do not touch.
- 6) Add any designs to fill in any empty spaces.
- 7) Give her your card and enjoy your present with her.
- 8) Remember to take a few pictures of the card for memory's sake.
